

In these early days of Advent, let us take a few moments to consider how we will go about this. One way we can spiritually prepare is to reflect on those who make this celebration of Christmas possible. The first person that comes to mind is our Blessed Mother. This week, we will have two opportunities to reflect on this amazing woman. The first is on Monday since the feast of the Immaculate Conception landed on a Sunday this year, it was transferred to Monday. The second is on Thursday when we celebrate the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Both these feast days show us the power that Mary has in our lives. It also shows us how much she wants to be part of our lives. Her Immaculate Conception gives us so much hope for what humanity can become. The story of the beginning of John the Baptist's ministry as prophet opens with a list of the major rulers at the time. St. Luke uses this to illustrate that John's announcement of the Messiah will have worldwide impact.




Busy at PREP! Our PREP Students made their own Advent Wreaths in class!

# Lt. Patty Simons Food Drive

The students of Saint Francis of Assisi School will be participating in the Lt. Patty Simons Food Drive. Please send in needed supplies to help the needy families in the Norristown area. Please give what you can in support of this worthy cause.

Now in its 29<sup>th</sup> year, the Law Enforcement Food Drive was dedicated in 2007 to the memory of Norristown Police Officer Lt.
