

SUNDAY, JULY 28, 2024

Reflection by Rev. Richard J. Smith

Many times in the letters of St. Paul, we hear him call us to live a life that is worthy of the call we have received. This time, in his letter to the Ephesians, he gives us some pointers on how we can do this. We are encouraged to do so with all humility and gentleness, with patience and bearing with one another through love. Now there are a few other ways he tells us but I want to focus on where we should begin according to Paul. We are told to begin with humility. Interesting how he doesn't tell us to begin with faith or with love but with humility. Why is that? Part of being humble is acknowledging that we don't always have the answer. We must acknowledge that a lot of the times, what we think is right is wrong. In order to be humble, we must admit that the way someone else thinks is the right way. This is the humility that Paul is calling us to live out. The humility we need to be open to is one that says that God's ways and not our own is the path to follow. Now this kind of humility opens us up to the grace that God wishes to give each of us. Paul himself had to do the same thing. He first believed that he was right and saw the followers of Jesus as inferior. After encountering Jesus, he humbled himself to the possibility that what he thought and believed was wrong. This humility opened Paul to so much and because of it he was able to do so much for God. We have all been called to do the same. We have all been called to do great things for God and we can. It starts with humility.

Debemos de reconocer que muchas veces lo que pensamos que esta bien esta mal. Para ser humilde debemos reconocer que la manera en que piensan los demás es la manera correcta. Esta es la humildad que Pablo nos llama a vivir. La humildad a la que debemos estar abiertos es aquella que dice que los caminos de Dios y no los nuestros son el camino a seguir. Ahora bien, este tipo de humildad nos abre a la gracia que Dios desea darnos a cada uno de nosotros. El propio Pablo tuvo que hacer lo mismo. Primero creyó que tenía razón y vio a los seguidores de Jesús como inferiores. Después de encontrarse con Jesús, se humilló ante la posibilidad de que lo que pensaba y creía estaba mal. Esta humildad abrió a Pablo a muchas cosas y gracias a ellas pudo hacer mucho por Dios. Todos hemos sido llamados a hacer lo mismo. Todos hemos sido llamados a hacer cosas grandes por Dios y podemos hacerlo. Comienza con humildad.

Saint of the Week: Saint Alphonsus Liguori

Feast Day: August 1

St. Alphonsus was born in Marianella, near Naples, then part of the Kingdom of Naples, on September 27, 1696, and was the oldest of 7. He was unable to be in the military, so pursued law, at the University of Naples, where he graduated with doctorates in civil and canon law at 16, and at the age of 18, joined the Confraternity of Our Lady of Mercy. He left the law field and became a priest in 1723, and was ordained on December 21, 1726.

Did you know... St. Alphonsus is the Patron Saint of vocations, confessors, arthritis, and lawyers?

He became known for his way of preaching, which was very simple. His sermons were very effective at converting those who had been alienated from their faith. On November 9, 1732, he founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, and was named Bishop of Sant'Agata dei Goti in 1762. Alphonsus reformed the seminary and spiritually rehabilitated the clergy and faithful, and even suspended those priests who celebrated Mass in less than 15 minutes. He passed away on August 1, 1787 at age 90.

Did you know... St. Alphonsus was a prolific author, with 111 works on spirituality and theology that have 21,500 editions and translations into 72 languages?
