



SUNDAY, JANUARY 28, 2024 ______ Reflection by Rev. Richard J. Smith

There is an odd dichotomy in the scriptures. The people who should be acknowledging who Jesus is reject him all the time and those who should be rejecting Jesus point him out all the time. The people that Jesus came to save and show the love of God seem to always be confused and lack understanding while the demons that Jesus casts out know exactly who he is and acknowledge him. I've always used this as a barometer in my own life. Clearly, I can do better than a demon when recognizing Jesus in my life. So how can we go about better recognizing Christ in our lives?

It can start with how we attend Mass. It is at Mass that we encounter Christ directly in the Eucharist. By coming to Mass early and spending some extra time after Mass, we can spend more time acknowledging who Jesus is and how much He means to us. There is nothing in our day more precious and rewarding than spending time with Christ. Let us over the next few weeks work on how we attend Mass so we can better acknowledge Jesus in the world. Las personas que Jesús vino a salvar y mostrar el amor de Dios parecen estar siempre confundidas y carentes de comprensión, mientras que los demonios que Jesús expulsa saben exactamente quién es él y lo reconocen. Siempre he usado esto como barómetro en mi propia vida. Claramente, puedo hacerlo mejor que un demonio al reconocer a Jesús en mi vida. Entonces, ¿cómo podemos reconocer mejor a Cristo en nuestras vidas?

Esto puede comenzar con la manera en que asistimos a Misa. Es en la Misa donde encontramos a Cristo directamente en la Eucaristía. Al venir a Misa temprano y pasar más tiempo después de Misa, podemos dedicar más tiempo a reconocer quién es Jesús y cuánto significa para nosotros. No hay nada en nuestros días más precioso y gratificante que pasar tiempo con Cristo. Trabajemos durante las próximas semanas en cómo asistimos a Misa para que podamos reconocer mejor a Jesús en el mundo.



Reading I: Deuteronomy 18: 15-20

Prophets will be "raised up" as the need arises. Then the people must listen to these authentic prophets called by Yahweh to succeed Moses.

Reading II: 1 Corinthians 7: 32-35

Paul offers clear advice to both the married and the unmarried in the community. Yet he does not impose any solution, as they strive for true "adherence to the Lord."

Gospel: Mark 1: 21-28

Mark concludes his stories of Jesus' healing with the tag that "His fame spread everywhere," even though it sometimes did so against Our Lord's will. Above all, He taught "with authority."

For it is in giving that we receive; it is in
