SUNDAY, MARCH 10, 2024

Reflection by Rev. Richard J. Smith

Watch any sports event and eventually you will see someone with a sign that says John 3:16. It's been used so many times in varying ways I wonder if those who use it even know what it truly means. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." We could spend a lifetime just with this one verse. The impact of this verse has reverberated through time and you and I are still feeling its effects. You can imagine how hard it is to compress its power to a small article for the bulletin. However, this is exactly what we are preparing for this Lent. Lent is a time of preparation for us to celebrate this loving act of our Heavenly Father. That He cared so much for us, that He did not want to see us captured and defined by our sins that He decided to show us how deep that love for us

To add to this, we are also shown how much Jesus shared in that love for us by freely accepting this plan and becoming one of us to die for us. The culmination of all of this explodes for us on Easter. As we have arrived at the midpoint of Lent, let us reevaluate how we have used our time. Have we been properly preparing for this explosion of Divine Love? You can only answer that question but when we take into consideration what it is we are preparing to celebrate, it does give us a better focus for our efforts. Let us double our efforts in these final weeks of Lent so we may fully be embraced and appreciate the full meaning of John 3:16. Let us all get caught up in the explosion of God's eternal love for us all.

El impacto de este versículo ha resonado a través del tiempo y tú y yo todavía sentimos sus efectos. Puedes imaginar lo difícil que es comprimir su poder en un pequeño artículo para el boletín. Sin embargo, esto es exactamente lo que estamos preparando para esta Cuaresma. La Cuaresma es un tiempo de preparación para celebrar este acto de amor de nuestro Padre Celestial. Que Él se preocupaba tanto por nosotros, que no quería vernos capturados y definidos por nuestros pecados, que decidió mostrarnos cuán profundo era ese amor por nosotros.

Además de esto, también se nos muestra cuánto Jesús compartió ese amor por nosotros al aceptar libremente este plan y convertirse en uno de nosotros para morir por nosotros. La culminación de todo esto estalla para nosotros en la Pascua. Cómo hemos llegado al punto medio de la Cuaresma, reevalúe cómo hemos usado nuestro tiempo. ¿Nos hemos estado preparando adecuadamente para esta explosión de Amor Divino? Sólo se puede responder a esa pregunta, pero cuando tomamos en consideración qué es lo que nos estamos preparando para celebrar, eso nos da un mejor enfoque para nuestros esfuerzos. Duplicamos nuestros esfuerzos en estas últimas semanas de Cuaresma para que podamos ser plenamente aceptados y apreciar el significado completo de Juan 3:16. Dejemos que todos queden atrapados en la explosión del amor eterno de Dios por todos nosotros.


