LETTER / CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY TO BE A GODPARENT OR CONFIRMATION SPONSOR & LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

The **Godparent** for Baptism or **Sponsor** for Confirmation must obtain a <u>Letter/</u>
<u>Certificate of Eligibility</u> from the parish where he / she is <u>currently registered and</u>
<u>attends Mass regularly</u>. The <u>Letter/Certificate of Eligibility</u> states that you are a <u>current registered member of the parish</u>. That you are in good standing and live a life in accordance with Catholic teachings (did not leave the Catholic faith for another religion, if married that you are in a valid Catholic marriage).

LETTERS / CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY...

IS FROM the parish where you <u>currently live and attend Mass regularly</u>.

IS NOT FROM the parish where you attended school.

IS NOT FROM the parish where you made your sacraments.

IS NOT FROM the parish where your parents live.

In the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, parishes have physical geographic boundaries. Where you **currently** live determines within which parish boundaries you live.

If you got married and moved – **REGISTER IN YOUR NEW PARISH**If you moved because of work – **REGISTER IN YOUR NEW PARISH**If you moved away and have since moved back into the area - **RE-REGISTER IN YOUR PARISH.**
