## Reflection by Rev. Richard J. Smith

St. Paul shows us the interesting and powerful relationship he has with the Gospel. He explains it to the Corinthians in a bit of a word puzzle which took me a few readings to see what he was trying to share. Paul sees his mission of spreading the Gospel as a response to the Gospel. He doesn't see it just as an obligation but more of a commitment to what the Gospel has given him.

The Gospel, Jesus himself, quite literally changed his life in a way he is still processing. Later on, he would describe it that he would burst if he didn't preach the Gospel. What is so powerful about this is that his response is out of gratitude and love to the Gospel. Let us today, through the example of St. Paul, learn to fall in love with the Gospel. If we can build a loving and committed relationship with the scriptures, then we too can preach and spread the Gospel just like St. Paul.

Si podemos construir una relación amorosa y comprometida con las Escrituras, entonces nosotros también podremos predicar y difundir el Evangelio tal como San Pablo.

For Paul, the healing of hearts is itself a blessing, flowing as it does from the gospel.

#### **Gospel: Mark 1; 29-39**

The cure of Peter's mother-in-law happens so quickly and fully that it is truly miraculous. The evening cures so many others stresses the love and the hope Jesus offers to all those who trust Him.
