SUNDAY, JULY 7, 2024 Reflection by Rev. Richard J. Smith

Scholars have wasted a great deal of time trying to figure out what the "thorn" is that Paul is telling the Corinthians. Could it be all the times he was marooned or attacked in his travels? Could it be all those who rejected him or those who misunderstood what he was presenting to them? Whatever it may have been is not important. What is important is how Paul handled it. He trusted in God when He tells him, "My grace is sufficient for you". Every challenge Paul faced in life he was able to overcome because Christ made this promise to him that he would be with him always. This is the same promise that Jesus has made to us. Think back to all those difficult moments of your life and see how you were able to rise above all of it. It may have taken everything you had to get through it, but you did so not by yourself but with the grace of God. This is why Paul boasts in his weaknesses. It is in his weak moments that he can truly see the grace of God working in his life. We can do the same thing. In our frailty, in our weakness, we see how much Jesus reaches out to us to help us up and to move forward. So, I encourage you, challenge your limitations and weaknesses today. You have already been given the grace of God to overcome everything.

En nuestra fragilidad, en nuestra debilidad podemos ver cuánto Jesus se acerca a nosotros para ayudarnos a levantarnos y caminar hacia adelante. Así que te animo a desafiar tus limitaciones y debilidades hoy. Ya se te ha dado la gracia de dios para superar todo.

Reading I: Ezekiel 2: 2-5 Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary

The prophet is told that his mission will be to speak to Israelite rebels the message of Yahweh to a people "obstinate of heart."

Reading II: 2 Corinthians 12: 7-10

Paul acknowledges that any pride he might feel because of the revelations he received from God would be unjustified. In fact, he admits to a certain "thorn in the flesh" from which he suffers constantly.

Gospel: Mark 6: 1-6a

Jesus is rejected by His own family, because His teachings were repulsive to them. In turn He concludes that "a prophet has no honor in his native place."

Saint of the Week: Benedict of Nursia

Feast Day: July 11

St. Benedict was born in Nursia, Italy to a Roman Noble. He was sent to Rome to study, but chose instead to settle in the mountains, where he met a monk, Saint Romanus of Subiaco, who encouraged him to become a hermit.

Did you know... St. Benedict's sister, Scholastica, is also a Saint? Her feast day is February 10.

After some years, Benedict became known and respected in the area, and the local monks asked him to become their abbot. He accepted, but after a time, their differences became too great, and the monks tried to poison him multiple times. Each time, their attempts failed. Finally, Benedict left the area, founding monasteries along the way.

Did you know... St. Benedict is regarded as the founder of Western Christian monasticism?

Benedict died of a fever not long after his sister (on March 21, 547 according to tradition), and was buried in the same tomb. His feast day is now celebrated on July 11, but in the pre-1970 General Roman Calendar, his feast is kept on March 21.

Did you know... St. Benedict is the patron Saint against poison, against curses, of agricultural workers, farmers, and of students, among other things?
