

SUNDAY, JULY 21, 2024 Reflection by Rev. Richard J. Smith

As you have heard me say several times before, there are some readings that are gut checks for clergy. This weekend is one of them. Now, please do not think I write this wanting you to put me on a pedestal. That is the one thing I will never ask of you. That is how you get priests like the ones Jeremiah is talking about. Those priests who have misled the people and have led the people away from God. Jeremiah ends this passage talking about the Messiah and how he will lead the people back to God. That is the kind of priest that I am striving to be and the kind that every Catholic deserves to have in their lives. To achieve this goal, it takes a lot of work. More importantly, it takes a great deal of trust in Christ, the High Priest. The Apostles last week were sent out to be the kind of priests that leads the people of God closer to their Lord. Today, we hear how successful they were because they trusted Christ. They did a lot of good not for themselves but for the people. Yet, look how the passage ends today. Jesus is moved with pity because he sees the crowd. He sees that there is so much to do and yet not enough to do the work. This is why I ask for your prayers so often. There is so much to be done and it is so easy to slip into doing the work of God for the praise and not the people. So I ask you once again, for myself and for all priests, pray that we do not lose focus on why we were called to the priesthood. Not for our own glory or the perks that may come from it. We were called to serve the people of God and help you all understand and receive His love more and more each day.

Esos sacerdotes que han extraviado al pueblo y lo han alejado de Dios. Jeremías termina su pasaje hablando del Mesías y de cómo él lidera al pueblo de vuelta a Dios. Ese es el tipo de sacerdote que yo estoy esforzándome por ser y el tipo que cada Catolico merece tener en sus vidas. Para alcanzar esta meta, toma mucho trabajo. Aún más importante, toma mucha confianza en Dios, el Sumo Sacerdote. Los Apóstoles, la semana pasada fueron enviados a ser el tipo de sacerdotes que acercan al pueblo de Dios a su señor. Hoy escuchamos que tan exitosos fueron porque confiaron en Cristo. Hicieron mucho bien no para ellos mismos sino para la gente. Sin embargo, miren cómo terminó hoy el pasaje. Jesús se conmueve al ver la multitud. Ve que hay mucho por hacer y aún no lo suficiente para realizar el trabajo. Por eso pido tan a menudo sus oraciones. Hay mucho por hacer y es muy fácil caer en hacer la obra de Dios para la alabanza y no para el pueblo. Así que les pido una vez más, por mí y por todos los sacerdotes, que oren para que no perdamos el foco en por qué fuimos llamados al sacerdocio. No para nuestra propia gloria o los beneficios que puedan derivarse de ella. Fuimos llamados a servir al pueblo de Dios y ayudarlos a todos a comprender y recibir su amor mas y mas cada día.

Saint of the Week: Saint James the Greater Feast Day: July 25

St. Bonaventure was born in Bethesda, in the Roman Empire, and was one of the Twelve Apostles. He was the son of Zebedee and Salome. Salome was a sister of Mary (mother of Jesus) which made James the Great a cousin of Jesus. He is also the brother of John the Apostle.

Did you know... St. James is the Patron Saint of Spain, woodcarvers, and pilgrims?

James was a follower of Jesus, and one of the first disciples. He preached in Hispania, and after his death, was buried there, in what is now the Santiago de Compostela in Galicia. He was the first of the Apostles to be Martyred.

Did you know... St. James is called "the Greater" to distinguish him from the Apostle James "the Less," with "greater" meaning older or taller, rather than more important?
