SUNDAY, October 6, 2024 Reflection by Rev. Richard J. Smith

Over the summer, I hosted two nights inviting couples who were married but not married in the Church. I wanted to give them an opportunity to experience the power and grace found in the Sacrament of Marriage. What a thrill it is to report that over a dozen couples came forward during those two days. I can not express in words the joy it brings to me to see a couple come together in the Sacrament of Marriage. Our readings this weekend point to what a man and woman are welcoming into their lives. A husband and wife are meant to make the other complete and a better person. Look how in Genesis, both Adam and Eve are not named nor say anything until they have each other. They bring the best out of each other and aid one another to be better. This is what should happen in this sacrament. As I prepare couples for the sacrament, I always tell them that the love they have between each other can and will grow if they welcome Christ into their marriage. The Sacrament is not meant for a day but for a lifetime. I would encourage all our married couples, from time to time, to look back on their wedding day. See how the vows you recited prepared you for a lifetime of growth with one another. See how by welcoming Christ into your marriage that you have fallen even more in love than the day you said I do. This will not just strengthen your marriage but you both will become an example for the rest of us. You will show us what we can do by welcoming Christ even more into our own lives. This is why it is so important that we support and encourage marriage rooted in the love of Christ. Let us this week keep in our prayers all married couples that they remain strong in the love of Christ for themselves and for all of us.


